## Turner Chemistry Award

The Charles William Turner Award has been established to honor Bill Turner, distinguished A. E. Staley Manufacturing Company chemist. A cash award will be given each year to the outstanding graduating chemistry student at St. Teresa High School in Bill's name.

Mr. Turner joined A.E. Staley Manufacturing Co. in 1953 and was employed there as a research chemist until his death in 1981. He began his career in Technical Service in Applications

Research; later he was the Group Leader of Technical Service in Industrial Products Research & Development. Prior to his death in 1981, he was the Section Manager of Technical Service & Product Development of Industrial Products Research and Development, where he was responsible for new product development for the paper industry, as well as industrial starch technical service.

During his career at Staley, Mr. Turner was credited with the development of two starch patents for the manufacturing of paper. One of the patented starch products was named CWT, in his honor.

The Robert Turner Scholarship Fund was established in 2003 in The Community Foundation in honor of Bill's brother Bob Turner, a long-time and beloved Decatur educator.
